### FULL-TIME VIRTUAL LEARNING

The Clear Lake School District will offer a completely online education (virtual learning) option for the 2020-2021 school year. This is provided as an option for families seeking an alternative to attending the traditional school setting due to COVID-19 concerns.

Virtual learning is an instructional delivery model in which learning takes place at home, taught by certified online teachers. Parents/guardians play a key role in helping their student(s) to be successful learning at home.

### VIRTUAL LEARNING PARTNER

Clear Lake School District will partner with **Edgenuity** to provide full-time virtual learning services.

- Full-time virtual learning is available to students in grades K-12 who reside in or open enroll in the Clear Lake School District.
- Students may participate free of cost.
- A district device will be provided to students.
- Students will remain members of the Clear Lake School District.
- Edgenuity teachers will carry out the scheduling, curricular pacing, instruction, assessment, and reporting of grades to the district.

### ENROLLMENT AND PARTICIPATION

- Families who choose full time virtual learning must commit for a minimum of one semester. (Families may opt-out and return to traditional school within the first 10 days if they do not feel that virtual learning is meeting their needs.)
- Students may return to the traditional classroom setting at semester breaks.
- Participation is approved through each building's administration on an individual basis based upon meeting each student's individual educational and social-emotional needs.
