Dear Parents & Guardians,

This has been an unprecedented year for cancellations due to inclement weather and I would like to thank you for your flexibility and understanding as the District navigated through all of the weather thus far. Our priority is the safety of our students above all things.

We have had a total of six school days that were canceled due to inclement weather as well as a two-hour delayed start. In order to meet the minimum requirements for instructional hours as required by the state, there will be some changes to the District Calendar as well as changes to both of the building's schedules. These changes will begin on Monday, March 18, 2019 and remain in place until the end of this school year. Below are the changes for the remainder of this school year:

- **Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup>** will be changed to a full day for students.
- **Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>** will be the last day of school with an early release for students.
- **Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>** will be changed from an in-service day to a full day with students.
- Beginning on **Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>** school will begin two minutes earlier at both buildings for the remainder of the year.
- Beginning on **Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>** the High School will be dismissing students two minutes earlier from each lunch period for the remainder of the school year.
- Beginning on **Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>** the Elementary School will be dismissing students one minute earlier from each lunch period.
- All bus pick up and drop off times will remain the same for all students.

Thank you in advance for your flexibility and support with these changes. All decisions have been made to ensure the least amount of disruptions and we are doing our due diligence to ensure that every student receives the education they deserve. Thank you for your support.
