OPEN ENROLLMENT

What is Public School Open Enrollment?

Wisconsin's inter-district public school open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend school districts other than the one in which they live.

Who may participate in open enrollment?

Students in 5-year-old kindergarten to grade 12 may apply to participate in open enrollment.

Open enrollment for prekindergarten, 4-year-old kindergarten and early childhood education is limited. Parents should call 715.263.2114 to find out if their preschool-aged children qualify for open enrollment.

Do I need to reapply for my children already attending under Open Enrollment?

No. Pupils who are already Open Enrolled based on either a regular application or an Alternative application do not need to reapply to attend Clear Lake School District.

How and when may parents apply?

The Open Enrollment application period for the 2016-17 school year is open **February 1, 2016** and closes at 4:00 pm on **April 29, 2016**.

How do I apply for Open Enrollment for my student?

On-line (recommended) at <http://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment>

Although on-line application is recommended, paper applications may be obtained from the Department of Public Instruction or any school district after February 1, 2016 for the 2016-17 school year, and must be delivered (hand-delivery is recommended) to the nonresident school district during the application period.
