Dear Clear Lake Parent(s), Guardians and Students,

Welcome back to another new school year! We are excited to get the school year started at CLHS!

As part of the many changes we are making due to our COVID-19 planning, we are implementing a “staggered start” this school year at the Jr./Sr. High. All students in grades 10-12 will be reporting on Tuesday, September 1st for a full day of school. Grades 7-9 will be off.

On Wednesday, September 2nd, all students in grades 7-9 and any new students to the Clear Lake Jr/Sr High will be reporting for a full day of school. Grades 10-12 will be off on Wednesday Sept. 2nd.

Thursday, September 3rd will be a full day for all students grade 7-12.

Here're some advantages of offering our students a staggered start:

1. Jr. High and freshmen students get acclimated to the building, schedule, bathroom locations, lockers, lunch procedures, class meetings, etc. helping them with familiarity and getting comfortable with routines that lead to improved student success.
2. New students can go through their schedule for the day and get familiar with our facilities.
3. Teachers can plan “warm up” activities for the students to get to know each other, building strong classroom working relationships early on.
4. Students with schedule issues have more time to get adjustments made with Mrs. Koehler.
5. We will be printing student ID cards in house starting this year. It will give us the time to get those made for students. These cards will be used for point of sale purchase for lunch (barcodes on the cards), checking out library materials and entry to school events.

A few important reminders for you:
